A 55m (well under an hour and a half) run keeping away from trunk roads as much as possible but going through the centre of towns and a city so that filtering skills can be sharpened up.

Meet at Tesco's car park in Bury somewhere near the car clean area so that we can get under way at 09:00 **sharp**.

Cross under the A14 into Compeign Way then left onto the A134 at the first roundabout, over the next, then left on the B1506 to the Fornhams. Join the A1101 to the right. On leaving Lackfield turn left signposted Cavenham and on to Kentford. Into and through Newmarket and then take the 3rd exit at the roundabout onto the A1303 into Cambridge. Take 1st exit at East Road roundabout and follow the A603. Stay on this road when its designation is changed to the B1042 upon crossing the A1198 roundabout. Through Dunton then left at the roundabout on entering Biggleswade and shortly right at the next onto London Road - A6001 - and into the High Street. Turn right at the T jct mini roundabout then crossing the A1 roundabout onto the B658. The entrance to the Shuttleworth Collection is on the left about 2 miles along here although another roundabout has to be crossed. The main car park is immediately inside the entrance but if full there is further parking just past the hangars and to the left.
