For those who don't want to travel too far


Can you do all the 30 local destinations?

All the places on the Local list have a duplicate on the Remote list


We have looked for small linked places

- Its remote namesake, Bagthorpe, is a small village between Mansfield and Nottingham
- The Destination is *The Shepherds Rest* public house
- You might choose to take a picture and ride on
- As the destination is a pub, you might choose to get a meal/drink there
- You might prefer a Café. There are lots of cafes near but one in particular, says you can park, so its listed
